Paying by Centrepay

Abstudy Supplements

Two Abstudy supplements are available to eligible parents.

- 1) A supplement of \$156 per eligible child is paid to the school and is directed towards school fees. Parents need to apply for the supplement directly through Centrelink.
- 2) An additional supplement of \$79 per eligible child will also be directed towards school fees. Forms are available from the College – applications close 31 March 2022.

Secondary Assistance Scheme – (Student who receive Abstudy are NOT eligible)

An education Department assistance scheme is available to holders of either a Healthcare Card or Pension Card. The scheme provides \$235 for school assistance for eligible students in Years 7-12 and will be credited to College fees in June each year when proceeds are received from the government.

Forms must be filled out and witnessed in the Business & Finance Manager's office. Applications close at the end of Term 1 each year.

In 2022 the clothing allowance is \$115 and is available to students in Years 7-12 under the same conditions as Secondary Assistance.

This allowance is paid via EFT to your nominated bank account if the applicant is successful.

Insurance

The College has a student accident insurance policy covering all students 24 hours per day 7 days per week. (This cost is covered by the College).

Notice of withdrawal of a student

- a. Notice of withdrawal of a student must be given in writing to the Principal. A full term's notice must be given; for example, if the student is leaving at the end of Term 4, notice must be given by the last school day of Term 3.
- b. An offer of enrolment for boarding will be per term. Any request for withdrawal, subject to the provision of notice in (a), will require the balance of the boarding fees for the remainder of the term to be paid.
- c. Enrolment as a boarder in Year 12 is for the full academic year.
